**Sub: Haulage charges recoverable for movement of
containers in privately owned wagons.**

- 1.0 In continuation of letter No.2006/TT-III/73/8 dated 1.7.2008, it has been decided to give a rebate of 10% for **domestic** traffic for weight categories above 20 MTs subject to the condition that the applicable rate after rebate will not be less than the corresponding rate as applicable as per Railway Board's letter no. No. 2006/TT-III/73/12 dt.11.10.2006. This rebate will be applicable with effect from 1.11.2008 to 31.12.2008.
- 2.0 It is clarified that the rebate is applicable only to the domestic traffic and not to EXIM traffic.
- 3.0 All other provisions contained in Railway Board's letter no. 2006/TT-III/73/8 dated 1.7.2008 will remain unchanged.
- 4.0 This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate in the Ministry of Railways.
