Sub: Revision of few paras contained in Chapter-III of Manual for Public Relations Department (First Edition – 2007)

In partial modification of Chapter-III of Manual for Public Relations Department (First Edition – 2007), Board (CRB & CEO) has approved the following modifications/additions in few paras of Chapter-III pertaining to grant of permission for film shooting in Railway premises/trains:-

2. Existing Para 5.7 of Chapter-III may be replaced as:

Observance of safety and security regulations during the shooting. While allowing shooting in the normal run of a train, it may be ensured that shooting by travelling on footboards/roof tops and any other place/location which Zonal Railways think is detrimental to Railways and/or fatal/lethal to the shooting party is not allowed. It has to be ensured further that no inconvenience is caused to other passengers. Similarly, shooting should not be allowed on tracks while there is any movement of a train. During the daytime, shooting at crowded railway stations should be avoided to ensure that normal functioning of the railways is not affected adversely and there is no inconvenience to the rail users.

3. Existing Para 6.3 of Chapter-III may be replaced as:

The amount of Security Deposit may be standardized for each Zonal Railway by the General Managers in consultation with the respective PFAs, in order to avoid delays that occur while deciding the amount of Security Deposit for each case.

4. Existing Para 7.3 of Chapter-III may be replaced as:

A standardized policy decision may be taken by each Zonal Railway to fix the comprehensive insurance amount on one time basis, in order to avoid delays that occur while deciding the amount of Comprehensive insurance for each case.

5. Existing Para 8.4 of Chapter-III may be replaced as:

The Licence fee for shooting of Feature Films and Advertisement Films in railway premise/trains is indicated below:

4	Moving/stabled trains (or any other railway rolling stock)	Rs. 45,000/- (Rs. Forty Five thousand)
