You may recall a representation given by FROA bringing to your notice that the 1987 Exam batch of all organised Group A Railway Services had not been granted Non-Functional HAG despite being eligible for the same and also despite the recommendations of the DPC for grant of functional HAG having been made in March 2019 itself has not been promoted as yet.

2. FROA would like to reiterate its earlier position on the subject and requests you that the DOPT and Ministry of Finance may be approached again for grant of Non-functional HAG to the 1987 Examination Batch of all organised Group A Railway Services w.e.f. the date of posting of the first officer of the 1990 batch of the IAS (equivalent to 1989 Examination batch of all Railway Services) as per extant rules. FROA would also like to point out that many officers of other Central Services of this batch have already been empanelled as Additional Secretaries and posted in that capacity in various ministries of the Government of India including in the Ministry of Finance.
3. FROA would also like to point out that the 1991 batch of the IAS (equivalent to 1990 Examination batch of all Railway Services) have been empanelled as Additional Secretary in the Government of India this week itself (copy of the list is enclosed for reference). This makes the 1988 Examination batch of the Railway Services eligible for being considered for Non-functional HAG.
4. FROA would also like to represent that such delay in getting just dues even seven months after the date of the DPC recommendations for promotion to HAG, etc. and even non-functional HAG is causing great distress and demoralisation amongst officers.
