Sub: Provision of Leaf Gates on manned LC Gates

Progress of manning of unmanned gates has been about 300 per year, whereas for the year 2010-11, target of manning of unmanned level crossing gates has been fixed as 4000. And at all manned level crossing gates, lifting barriers are required to be provided. However, due to sudden increase in requirement of lifting barrier, there may be difficulty in providing the same during 2010-11.

In view of above situation, Board (ME & MT) has approved provision of leaf gates at level crossing gates with TVU between 6000 and 3000. The same shall be subsequently replaced by lifting barrier. However, railway will make best efforts to provide lifting barriers in the first instance itself, if the same can be made available.

Railways may like to do needful accordingly.
