Sub: Green Certification of Railway Stations by CII

Indian Railways have signed an MoU with CII for promoting facilitation of green initiatives in Indian Railways and Stations on 13.9.2019 for a period of 3 years. So far 13 railway stations have been certified green and these stations have reported substantial annual savings besides other intangible benefits like improved station facility management, daylight & ventilation and thermal comfort for occupants, effective waste management, improved pedestrian and vehicular access to station & low carbon mobility options, user-friendly design for differently abled, use of green products for construction & renovation. The various aspects of green certification of stations include sustainable station facility, health, hygiene & sanitation, water & energy efficiency and smart & green initiative.

Railway Board has approved a proposal for green certification of one major station (out of NSG 1-4) per Division of each Zonal Railway at a maximum cost of ₹6 lakh per station. CII will depute a technical staff at each zone for liasoning and follow up and will also hold a capacity building program (on chargeable basis-per zone - ₹ 75,000) as well as develop an exclusive app for green railway station and online tool for submission of documents and review. They will also provide additional support for implementation by organizing a meet on green products and technology suppliers for cross fertilization of ideas. These are exclusive of GST which is payable as per rates applicable.
