Sub: Fortnight cleanliness drive to check cleanliness standards in trains.

Indian Railways is a major contributor to Swachh Bharat Mission and take every effort in maintaining cleanliness through its flagship program "Swachh Rail Swachh Bharat". Cleanliness inspection/superchecks are conducted periodically to maintain high standards of cleanliness so as to provide a comfortable and hygienic environment to travelling passengers.

2. In continuation of the aforesaid efforts, it has been decided that a fortnight special cleanliness drive should be launched from 10th March 2025 to 23rd March 2025 to check/maintain cleanliness standards in trains. During drive, following activities must invariably be included:-

1. Intensive inspection/Cleaning of trains at washing lines by team of Supervisors/Officers during primary maintenance.
2. Intensive inspection of trains at Station by team of officers/supervisors and staff in all OBHS trains.
3. Anti-littering to be ensured in coaches.
4. Special focus on Bio-Toilets maintenance should be ensured.
5. Quality of linen should be checked.
6. Pantry Car cleaning should be checked, quality of food and its hygiene also be checked.
7. Waste generated/collected by OBHS and pantry cars staff should be kept properly and handed over at identified station/location, it should be ensured that the waste is not discharged on tracks.
8. Suggestions/feedback should also be obtained from passengers and immediate action be taken therof.

3. Active participation from Railway men should be ensured and general public may be educated to keep the trains clean through PA system and IEC devices.

4. Detailed report of the drive along with before and after photos may be furnished on daily basis on Email Id: advenhm@rb.railnet.gov.in. A complete report detailing number of trains covered, plastic removed(in tones), anti-littering drives, number of SMS feedback received from passengers etc. should be provided to this office after completion of the drive and not later than 30.03.2025.
