**Sub: Decision taken in Board meeting held on 2 February 2018**

**Ref: Pay & Use Toilet Policy issued vide Board's Commercial Policy Circular Nos. 46 of 07.06.2006 and Commercial Policy Circular No. 34 of 05.06.2012**

Full Board in its meeting held on 2 February 2018 considered the above Pay and Use Toilet Policies and decided that:

Considering that the provision of toilets in adequate numbers is essential for effective implementation of Swacch Bharat Abhiyan, it is desirable that optimum number of toilets are constructed with proper hygienic maintenance and adequate facilities.

In this regard, following course of action is approved:

- i. DRMs are empowered to make location specific assessment to decide whether construction/operation/maintenance of the pay & use toilet should be taken up as an 'earning contract' or as a 'service contract'.
- ii. The Pay & Use Toilet Policy Circular No. 34 of 2012 to be examined afresh and simplified policy to be issued by Transformation Cell within two weeks.
- iii. DRMs are empowered to sign MoUs with Sulabh or other similar and reputed "Not for Profit" agencies/organizations which specialize in construction/operation/maintenance of toilets.

This issues with the concurrence of Associate Finance of Transformation Cell, Railway Board.
