Sub: Hub & Spoke policy for movement of Container Trains.

Ref: (i) RB's letter no. 2011/TT-III/73/9/vol.II dated 16.05.2017

Please refer to RB's Container Circular No. 06/2017 issued vide letter No. 2011/TT-III/73/9 vol. II dated 16.05.2017, Para 3.1 (b) may be read as under:

Existing Para 3.1 (b)	Revised Para 3.1 (b)
Inter - Hub distance shall not be less than 750 kms.	Inter – Hub distance shall not be less than 500 kms.

The above revised Para 3.1 (b) is valid on experimental basis initially for one year to assess the financial outcome of the scheme.

Zonal Railway shall maintain record of movement of containers for inter-hub distance of 500 kms un Hub and Spoke policy so that mid-term review may also be taken assess effectiveness of the scheme.

These will come into force from 16th November, 2021

All other instructions issued vide letter under above references will continue to hold good.
