ORDER


Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) have decided to constitute a Committee to review policy issues governing commercial activities for sundry other earnings. The Committee will consist of the following:-

2. The Terms of Reference of the Committee will be as under:

The committee will review, in a phased manner, policy guidelines/circulars issued from Railway Board related to commercial activities (Minor Heads/Sub Heads/Detailed Heads) for sundry other earnings as given in Abstract 'Z' of the Finance Code (Volume-II) of Indian Railways with a view to examine and simplify the procedures, suggest broad overarching policy framework under which these activities should be managed, procedures of contract management and delegation of powers for handling these contracts at zonal and divisional levels to enhance potential for sundry other earnings.

3. The Committee should submit its report within a period of 45 days from the date of its first sitting.
4. The Headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.
5. TC(FM) Branch of Railway Board will be the Nodal Branch for functioning of the Committee. Therefore, submission of report of the Committee for consideration of Railway Board, implementation of its recommendations and all related issues including Parl. Questions, RTI cases and other formalities with regard to the Committee, shall be dealt with by TC(FM) Branch.
6. The Chairperson, Convener, Secretary and official Members of the Committee will draw TA/DA as per extant rules.
