Sub: Reporting of Punctuality at Divisional Level.

Over the last one year emphasis has been laid on truthful reporting of punctuality & asset failures and bring about a culture of righteousness in reporting & maintaining the statistical data, and therefore FY 2018-19 was declared as 'Zero Year'.

Logging of punctuality in right earnest is equally important for system improvement. In this regard Board (CRB) have approved the following:

1. Division shall be the final authority to decide the cause of the punctuality and its head of logging, under their jurisdiction.
2. In case of any dispute, the decision of ADRM, looking after the Operations, shall be final.
3. The matter shall preferably be resolved on the same day & in any case, not beyond D+2 days. (D-Day of occurrence)
4. CRIS shall modify the ICMS software accordingly and issue the necessary user IDs to ADRMs.
