
Sub:- Extension on online RDBMS based SDT applications-

Instructions had been issued by Board, in the letter under reference for extension of online RDBMS based SDT applications-AFRES & PRIME on Railways. In order to ensure timely completion of the project, a Task Force headed by FA&CAO, incharge of EDP Centre and active involvement of CPOs to oversee implementation in their department have also been envisaged. Unfortunately, progress in this regard has been slow on Railways and also there is an apparent lack of involvement of Personnel Department in this project despite AM(S)'s letter mentioned above directing CPOs to extend coordination to the Task Force in the extension of the application in Personnel Department.

The need for timely implementation of these applications need not be overemphasised, as you would be aware of the benefits arising out of it. It is therefore, imperative that the progress of implementation of these applications is monitored at your level. Timely submission of the reports by the CPOs and the Team Leaders to Board may also be ensured.
