Sub:- Quantum of debit in case of loss of SPTM/UTS tickets.

Please refer to Board's letter of even no. dated 13.6.2005 on quantum of debits in case of loss of SPTM/UTS tickets which inter-alia envisage that the maximum no. of passengers that could be booked on a single SPTM/UTS ticket would be restricted to 4 adults in case of II class (Mail/Exp. or ordinary), 2 adults in case of Sleeper Class and 1 adult in case of Upper Class except 1st AC or AC 2 Tier. In this regard, some of railways have sought clarification regarding maximum no. of children that can be booked on a single SPTM/UTS ticket. The matter has been examined and it is clarified that the maximum no. of passengers that can be booked per SPTM/ UTS ticket will remain same as stipulated in the instructions ibid. Accordingly, the instructions ibid are modified as under:

(i) The number of passengers per SPTM/ UTS ticket shall be restricted as under :-

Class	Maximum no. of passengers
II Class (Mail/Exp. or Ordinary)	4
Sleeper Class	2
Upper classes except 1 st AC or AC 2 Tier.	1

(ii) Issue of 1st AC and AC2 tier ticket from SPTM/UTS shall be disabled.

(iii) The above revision would also require following modifications in respect of quantum of debit in case of loss of SPTM/UTS tickets.

- (a) In case of missing tickets for which there is no accountal, the debit will be raised equivalent to 4 (four) II class Mail/ Express full fare for farthest destination in the system.
- (b) In case of cancellation/ modification of issued ticket, where both the original journey ticket and cancellation/ non-issued tickets are accounted for in the system, the debit will be raised as under :-

Situations	Quantum of debit
(i) When both original journey ticket and cancellation/ non-issued ticket are missing	Value of ticket accounted for in the system + full fare for maximum number of passengers allowed on a ticket to the farthest destination in II class Mail/Exp.
(ii) When original Journey ticket is missing and cancellation ticket/ non-issued ticket is available.	Value of ticket accounted for in the system.

(iii) When journey ticket is available and cancellation/ non-issued ticket is missing.	Full fare for maximum number of passengers allowed on a ticket to the farthest destination in II class Mail/Exp.
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The modalities as above will be applicable after necessary changes have been made in the SPTMs/ UTS. As far as old cases are concerned, the debits should be restricted to the number of passengers allowed to be booked on a SPTM/UTS ticket, if such a restriction has been imposed by the Zonal Railways, otherwise, Board's instructions prevailing at the time should be followed.

This issues with the concurrence of Commercial and Finance Directorates.





Sub: - Quantum of debits in case of loss of SPTM/ UTS tickets.

The matter regarding quantum of debits to be raised in case of loss of SPTM/ UTS tickets has been under Board's consideration for quite some time. The matter has since been examined and following decisions have been taken : -

(i) The number of passengers per SPTM/ UTS ticket shall be restricted as under : -

Class	Maximum no. of passengers
II Class (Mail/Exp. or Ordinary)	4 adults
Sleeper Class	2 adults
Upper classes except 1 st AC or AC 2 Tier.	1 adult

(ii) Issue of 1st AC and AC 2 tier ticket from SPTM/UTS shall be disabled.

(iii) The debit for missing SPTM/UTS ticket shall be regulated as under: -

- (a) In case of missing tickets for which there is no accountal, the debit will be raised equivalent to 4 (four) II class Mail/ Express fare for farthest destination in the system.
- (b) In case of cancellation/ modification of issued ticket, where both the original journey ticket and cancellation/ non-issued tickets are accounted for in the system, the debit will be raised as under : -


Situations	Quantum of debit
(i) When both original journey ticket and cancellation/ non-issued ticket are missing	Value of ticket accounted for in the system + value of maximum number of passenger allowed on a ticket to the farthest destination in II class Mail/Exp.
(ii) When original Journey ticket is missing and cancellation ticket/ non-issued ticket is available.	Value of ticket accounted for in the system.
(iii) When journey ticket is available and cancellation/ non-issued ticket is missing.	Value of maximum number of passenger allowed on a ticket to the farthest destination in II class Mail/Exp.

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The modalities as above will be applicable after necessary changes have been made in the SPTMs/ UTS. As far as old cases are concerned, the debits should be restricted to the number of passengers allowed to be booked on a SPTM/UTS ticket, if such a restriction has been imposed by the Zonal Railways, otherwise, Board's instructions prevailing at the time should be followed.


