**Sub:- Promotional prospects of the staff of Cash & Pay department-allowing Cashiers & Shroffs to be posted as Accounts Stock Verifiers.**

Attention is invited to Board's letter no. 2006/AC-II/20/10 dated 20/09/2006, vide which staff of Cash & Pay department have been permitted to appear in Appendix-2 and Appendix-3 IREM examinations and seek absorption in Accounts department. In this regard a suggestion was received from one of the Zonal Railways for allowing posting of willing staff of Cash & pay department as Accounts Stock Verifier where eligible Accounts Assistants/Jr. Accounts Assistants are not available or are not willing to opt for Accounts Stock Verifier.

The matter has been examined and it has been decided to allow Jr. Cashiers/Sr. Shroffs, PB-1 Rs. 5200-20200/Grade Pay Rs. 2400/-, Sr. Cashiers/Hd. Shroffs, PB-2, Rs. 9300-34800/Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- for being posted as Accounts Stock Verifier subject to the following conditions:-

1. First preference would be given to Accounts Assistants, PB-2 Rs. 9300-34800/Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- and in case of their non-availability to Jr. Accounts Assistants PB-1 Rs. 5200-20200/Grade Pay 2800/-. However in case no volunteers from Accounts Assistants/ Jr. Accounts Assistants is available, surplus staff of Cash & Pay department working in Grade Pay Rs. 2400/- and up to Rs. 4200/- i.e. Jr. Cashiers/Sr. Shroffs, PB-1 Rs. 5200-20200/Grade Pay Rs. 2400/- and Sr. Cashiers/Hd. Shroffs, PB-2 Rs. 9300-34800/Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- may be considered provided they have passed Appendix-2 IREM examination. No fresh appointment shall be made against the vacancies so caused in the Cash & Pay department.
2. Such staff on appointment as Accounts Stock Verifier shall be adequately trained by Inspector of Stores Accounts/Senior Accounts Stock Verifiers to make themselves familiar with the working of Stores department and role of Accounts Stock Verifiers.
3. Accounts Clerk/Shroffs, PB-1 Rs. 5200-20200/Grade Pay Rs. 1900/- shall not be considered for selection to the post of Accounts Stock Verifier Grade Pay Rs. 4200/-.
4. The lien/seniority of Cashiers/Sr. Shroffs appointed as Accounts Stock Verifier will be maintained in the parent department and their seniority in the cadre of Accounts Stock Verifier will be assigned as per the extant procedure.
