Please refer board's letter mentioned under reference about monsoon precaution whereas Zonal Railways are advised to take adequate monsoon precautions and necessary action as contained in IRPWM, Chapter-X "Patrolling of Railway line" and Chapter-XI/Part-C "Pre-monsoon precautionary measures"

Issuance of detailed guidelines on monsoon precautions to be taken by all the divisions, adequate monsoon reserves such as relieving spans, boulders, sand/quarry dust stacked at suitable location and loaded in wagons at appropriate stations in terms of Para 709 of IRBM and Para 1125 of IRPWM. Further, issuance of detailed guidelines on monsoon patrolling and protection of vulnerable Bridges/locations availability of sufficient bags filled with sand/quarry dust at suitable locations so that the same could be loaded in wagons urgently in case of emergency.

Conducting inspection jointly with the State Government and deficiencies, if any, may be made good through the State Government. Make arrangement with concerned metrological centre for receipt of bad weather warning (it should cover high velocity winds and cyclone as well as heavy rainfall). Maintain liaison with local authorities for real time monitoring of excess release of water from reservoirs/dams so that adequate protection of railway structure could be taken without loss of time.

Further details of RAW/RAT inspected so far as per BMS are listed herewith as annexure-A for information and early compliance please.

Monsoon (2023) is approaching shortly and hence Zonal Railways are advised to take adequate monsoon precautions and necessary action as contained in IRPWM, Chapter-X "Patrolling of Railway line" and Chapter-XI/Part-C "Pre-monsoon precautionary measures". Thus, Zonal Railways to confirm that they have:

• Issued detailed guidelines on monsoon precautions to be taken by all the divisions of the Zonal Railways.

 Adequate monsoon reserves such as relieving spans, boulders, sand/quarry dust stacked at suitable location and loaded in wagons at appropriate stations in terms of Para 709 of IRBM and Para 1125 of IRPWM.

• Issued detailed guidelines on monsoon patrolling and protection of vulnerable Bridges/locations.

• Sufficient bags filled with sand/quarry dust at suitable locations so that the same could be loaded in wagons urgently in case of emergency.

#### 2.0 In addition Zonal Railways should:


- Furnish the locations of monsoon reserve and available quantities of materials thereof in the Annexure enclosed.
- Conduct inspection jointly with the State Government and deficiencies, if any, may be made good through the State Government.
- Make arrangement with concerned metrological centre for receipt of bad weather warning (it should cover both high velocity winds and cyclone as well as heavy rainfall).
- Maintain liaison with local authorities for real time monitoring of excess release of water from reservoirs/dams so that adequate protection of railway structure could be taken without loss of time.
- 3.0 The action taken on above/details sought for should be furnished latest by 10.05.2023 by email on <a href="mailto:dcebsrb@gmail.com">dcebsrb@gmail.com</a> and <a href="mailto:bmcellrb@gmail.com">bmcellrb@gmail.com</a>.

Sub: Monsoon reserves

Ref.: Para 709 of IRBM and Para 724 of IRPMM

- Para 709 of IRBM and Para 724 of IRPWM provides that monsoon 1.0 reserves such as pitching stone, boulders, send/quarry dust etc. would be stacked at sultable locations in stacks and would also be kept ready loaded in wagons at appropriate stations for quick movement in case of emergency. The above paras also provide that the locations and quantity of reserve stock of pitching stone, boulders, sand/ quarry dust etc. to be kept on ground in stacks and loaded in wagons would be fixed by Chief Engineer/ Chief Bridge Engineer.
- 2.0 During recent monsoon damages on one of the railways, it has been observed that restoration could be expedited if synthetic cement bags filled with sand/quarry dust were readily available because a lot of time was taken in tilling sand/quarry dust in empty cement bags. It is therefore, desirable that out of the total quantity of sand/quarry dust prescribed by railway as monsoon reserve, a certain quantity should be kept filled in empty cement bags loaded in wagons. Bifurcation of send/quarry dust monsoon reserve to be kept in stacks/ loaded wagons and that filled in bags loaded in wagons be decided by PCE/CBE. Besides this, sufficient stock of empty synthetic cement bags should also be kept by the railways for further use in emergency.
