Minutes of meeting held on 22.01.2023

A Secretary level meeting was held between Ministry of Railways and MoRTH in Railway Board on 22.01.2023 to discuss the issues of MoR and MoRTH appearing in draft agenda items of 10th Group of Infrastructure Meeting (10th GOI) scheduled on 24.01.2023. The meeting was chaired by Shri Anil Kumar Lahoti, CRB & CEO and Ms. Alka Upadhyaya, Secretary, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways. The meeting was attended by senior officers from Ministry of Railways, MoRTH and NHAI (List of participants is attached).

The general/specific issues discussed and deliberated in the meeting are as under:

1. Land Lease / Transfer related issues:

The officials of NHAI requested for early transfer/ leasing of Railway land for various projects of NHAI. It was brought to the notice of MoRTH / NHAI that MoR has rationalized its land leasing policy with the approval of Cabinet and Master Circular on 'Policy for Management of Railway Land' has been issued on 04.10.2022. All the land related issues shall be dealt as per the revised policy. MoRTH / NHAI shall apply for leasing of railway land through on line portal IR-LSPS. Ministry of Railways has stipulated a time period of 90 days for approval of proposals of leasing / licensing of railway land.

2. P&E and supervision charges for ROBs:

NHAI / MoRTH requested for accepting one time charges of Rs. 5 lakhs (instead of P&E , Supervision Charges levied prior to 10.11.2014), even in case of validation / approval of GADs of ROB initiated prior to MOU dated 10.11.14 or wherein original GADs approved prior to MOU dated 10.11.2014 but due to change in project configuration revalidation of GADs asked subsequently. Meanwhile pending resolution of this issue, the ROB works may be allowed to continue by Railways with payment of one time charges as stated above.

It is decided that a consolidated list of such cases shall be shared by MoRTH/NHAI with MoR for one time exemption, which shall be considered and processed further for communicating sanction.

3. System review for monitoring and resolution of issues between MoRTH / NHAI and Railways:

- Presently Bi-monthly meetings are being conducted by CBE at Zonal Railway with MoRTH, NHAI and State Govt. for timely resolution of issues,

this meeting should be held on monthly basis. To enhance the effectiveness of the meetings, senior level officers from NHAI/MoRTH should attend the meeting. It was agreed during the meeting that Senior level officers will attend these meeting to resolve field level issues. CE (G)/Chief Engineer looking after the land matter in Zonal Head Quarters shall also be associated during the meeting for resolution of land related issues between NHAI and Railways.

- b) In addition to above, it was decided that AGM of Zonal Railway will hold a review meeting with Chief General Manager/NHAI and Regional Officers of MoRTH/NHAI on quarterly basis to monitor & resolve the issues unresolved in CBE level meetings.
- c) An online Portal to be set up by MoRTH / Railway for registering, monitoring and expeditious resolution of land and other matters. Alternatively, a module may be developed in IR-RRCAS portal for this purpose.

4. MoU for land matters

MoRTH/NHAI raised the issue, that sometimes targeted project of NHAI are affected due to claim of ownership issues of land by railways. As MoRTH/NHAI and Railways are Central Govt. entities, the progress of work should not be affected by such issues. A MoU may be entered between MoRTH/NHAI and Railways to accord working permission after deposition of amount as per railway records pending finalization of ownership issue. The amount so deposited, if found additional/deficit, may be adjusted/reimbursed at later stage. This shall be applicable vice-versa for railway projects also.

5. Span arrangement in Railway's ROW

NHAI/ MoRTH requested for allowing piers in Railway's ROW, if it is not obstructing Railway Track expansion plan.

As per Railway Board Letter dated 29.10.19,

- i. "For ROB being constructed in Railway yard or near yard, pier/abutment should be located just out-side/at the railway boundaries to the extent possible.
- ii. At other locations, if future requirement of track is not justified can be accommodated within 45 m, road span of track can be up to 45 meter.
- iii. In case of dispute, matter shall be decided by GM of Zonal Railway considering the future requirement and site feasibility.

Instruction issued vide letter dated 29.10.2019 will be re-iterated to Zonal Railways. Provision of pier location at boundary need not to be flatly insisted upon at all locations. As far as possible large span should be adopted

considering future requirements. NHAI/MoRTH may come up with new designs for superstructure for larger span in consultation with RDSO (Research Design and Standard Organisation).

6. Cost of utility shifting

NHAI /MoRTH requested that cost towards the replacement of structures may be borne by Railways as the facilities created by NHAI would also boost railway's infrastructure. Alternatively, Railways should only demand depreciated cost of their structures, in place of replacement value of new structures, as the structures are about 100 yrs old.

As per present practice, all the utilities are shifted by the infrastructure creating agencies like Metros, Railways on defense land, etc. at their cost. It was agreed that infrastructure creating authorities shall bear the entire cost of replacement of utilities.

7. MoU for Setu-Bhandhan Scheme

MoRTH decided to facilitate State Govts./ UTs for replacement of existing Level Crossings (LCs) on State Roads by construction of ROBs/ RUBs under SETU BANDHAN Program under CRIF Scheme which envisages replacement of LC by ROBs/RUBs on state roads (other than Village Roads) by single entity by State/expertise agencies through the funds allocated by MoRTH from the State's share.

Already a MoU exist between MoRTH and MoR for replacement of LCs on NH corridor by MoRTH / NHAI at their own cost. For other roads MoR has already revised the policy for construction of ROBs/RUBs in lieu of level crossings vide letter No. 2017/CE-IV/LX/Misc./244 (LCs) pt. dated 28.07.2022. As per revised policy;

- (i) All LC as per Railway's priority: 100% cost of work (excluding land acquisition, R&R, removal/shifting of utilities which shall be by state/ROA's, at their own cost) shall be borne by Railways for elimination of LC forming part of railway's priority (through CRIF fund).
- (ii) All LC not as per Railway's priority: 100 % cost of work shall be borne by State Governments / Road Owning Authority (ROA), if these entities decide to eliminate such LCs as per their priority on single entity basis.

As such tripartite MoU as suggested by MoRTH is not required, as the present policy of Railway largely aligned with Setu Bandhan scheme. Letter to MoRTH and Zonal Railway issued on 21.01.2023 in line with revised policy (dated 28.07.2022) of LC elimination of Railway which allows Road Owning Authority (ROA) to take up ROB at their own cost for ROA's priority.

8. Closure of Level Crossing (LCs) on commissioning of ROBs

- a) As per MoU dated 10.11.2014, all the LCs on NH Corridor are to be replaced by MoRTH / NHAI at their own cost. There are about 401 LCs on NH as on 01.04.22. At 24 LCs, ROBs commissioned but LCs not closed. MoRTH / NHAI shall reiterate instructions to ROs/PIUs to ensure closure of LCs at the time of commissioning of ROBs. ROB/RUB works at balance 377 LCs to be done.
- b) As per para A(7) of MOU, Subway should be provided in addition to ROBs at LC locations to facilitates movement of pedestrians & vehicular traffic. If not feasible, FOB with ramp shall be provided. MoRTH / NHAI shall reiterate instructions to ROs/PIUs to ensure provision of subway / FOB in addition to ROBs as per MOU.
- c). Wherever, RUB works underneath the Railway Line is required / committed by NHAI, Railway may agree to take up such RUB work as a deposit work of MoRTH/NHAI on mutual consent.
