
Sub: Infringements to 2135 mm (7ft) fixed

In terms of this office letter of even number dated 18.1.89 General Managers All Indian Railways were requested to furnish the sections to Board with copy to Director General (Civil) RDSO where track centres are less than 4570mm (15'-0") and the locations of structures where setting distances from centre line of track are less than 2135mm (7'-0"). RDSO was also requested that on receipt of the replies from all the railways they should send their specific recommendations to the Board in connection with the possibility of adoption of a width of 3500 mm for special design wagons without any projecting doors outside.

Since the above recommendations have not so far been received in this office, RDSO may therefore summarise the whole position received from the railways and send their recommendations to the Board immediately.
