

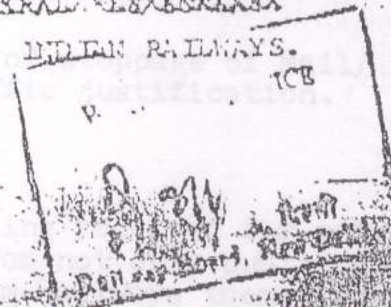

IN THE PARLIAMENT TO REVIEW ALL THE STOPPAGES GIVEN  
RECENTLY SO THAT THE LONG DISTANCE PASSENGERS DO NOT SUFFER  
MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS DESIRE THAT THE RAILWAYS SHOULD  
CONDUCT REVIEW OF ALL THE STOPPAGES PROVIDED TO MAIL/EXPRESS  
TRAINS DURING JANUARY, 1990 TO DECEMBER, 1991(.) AN  
ASSESSMENT OF THE ACTUAL UTILISATION OF THESE STOPPAGES  
BASED ON TICKETS ISSUED/COLLECTED INCLUDING WARRANTS AND  
MSTs, IF ANY SHOULD BE MADE DISTANCE-WISE SEPARATELY(.)  
IN CASE OF OFFERING OF TRAFFIC OF LESS THAN 10 PASSENGERS  
FOR DISTANCES BEYOND 160 KMS. IN CASE OF MAIL/EXPRESS  
TRAINS AND 500 KMS. IN SUPERFAST EXPRESS TRAINS, RAILWAYS  
MAY RECOMMEND THEIR WITHDRAWAL IN CASE OF ALTERNATIVE  
SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE(.) A STATEMENT INDICATING THE LIE  
OF STOPPAGES, DATE OF PROVISION, ACTUAL TRAFFIC, OFFERING  
AVAILABILITY OF ALTERNATIVE SERVICES AND RAILWAYS'  
RECOMMENDATIONS SHOULD BE SENT TO THIS OFFICE BEFORE  
1.2.1992(.) LORD DESIRE THAT IMMEDIATE ACTION SHOULD  
BE TAKEN ON THIS AND REPORT SENT WITHIN THE TARGET DATE(.)
