Sub: Permission for running of three coaches on either side of the SLR in passenger carrying short-distance trains.

Ref: Board's letter of even number dated 09-04-08.

Following receipt of proposals/requests from the railways on the above subject the matter was considered and the Board has agreed to permit running of three coaches on either side of the SLR for short distance trains (say up to 250 kms) provided 100% brake power is ensured and outer most coaches on either side (other than an inspection carriage) are anti telescopic. Board has also agreed to grant this dispensation on regular basis till further order and this permission will be valid for all sections on the railways where there is a need to run such trains as decided by the COMs.
