COMMERCIAL CIRCULAR NO. 25 OF 1989

Sub: Allotment of coaches on Full Tariff Rates.

In the context of enhancement of detention charges for coaches allotted on Full Tariff Rates, Ministry of Railways feel that parties will circumvent the payment of detention charges by requisitioning coaches for single trips instead of round trips. This will be particularly so in the case of short moves. While it is not possible to discourage single journey moves in case of foreign tourists and school children at the time of vacation for joining school and to return homes after the session, Ministry of Railways feel that normally there should be no occasion for parties to go on short trips in only one direction for the purpose of marriage, functions etc. Such groups should normally travel by regular trains by booking reserved accommodation. Therefore, Ministry of Railways desire that due care may please be taken not to allot reserved coaches on Full Tariff Rates for single journey to these parties unless in exceptional circumstances (where exceptions should be made by CPTS himself).
