My dear Sanwalka,

Please refer to your Railway's letter No. 7/Secy/26/SG/2004 dated 16.02.2005, addressed to Governor's Secretariat, Nagaland, regarding allotment of Saloon for His Excellency, the Governor of Assam.

The matter has been examined. It is advised that Rule 11 of the Governors (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1987, prescribes the entitlement of the Governors of the States while undertaking journey by train, including Saloons, and these rules are applicable to the Governors of all States, including newly created States of Uttaranchal, Jharkhand and Chhatisgarh, except Jammu & Kashmir. In these rules, it has been advised that the Governors shall be entitled to requisite a railway saloon for all his journeys within the State and shall be entitled to take with him not more than three persons without payment of any fare for them.

It is clarified that whenever saloon is requisitioned for the Governors as per the above rules, it will be given on Full Tariff Rates.

This is for information and necessary action.
