CHAPTER-I

1.0.0. INTRODUCTION:

- 1.1.0. Indian Railway is the largest public sector undertaking of Govt. of India with staff strength of about 12 lakh employees. The Railways in India are not only a mere transport agency, but also have deep social obligations to serve efficiently and fully the increasing needs of the countrymen.
- 1.2.0. Indian Railway has a welfare organisation under Personnel department to look after all types of grievances of employees as well as to provide various infrastructures for the benefit of its employees and their family members.
- 1.3.0. Ab initio, the Railway colonies were generally established outside the civil area. Then situation needs to provide infrastructure for education, inside the Railway colony especially for primary section.
- 1.4.0. Indian Railway organizes various types of schools at Jamalpur to provide education to employee's wards within the railway premises. The schools are Mixed Primary School, Middle Schools, Inter College for Higher Secondary education under CBSE.
- 1.5.0. In 21st century, Indian economy is growing faster than many other countries. Indian economy is now playing a very important role in global economy and many Indians are leading the various industries, offices and institutions through out the world. So, in India education is not now to learn letter, it is the essential instrument for Indians to compete the world. Indian parents are now trying to educate their wards through English Medium instead of regional language to cope up their child with present need. Moreover, India is a developing country, the Indian city, village, township are growing faster and stretched its width and breadth. Railway colonies are now within the greater civil area or adjacent the stretched civil area.
- 1.6.0. The Central Pay Commission Indian Railway has decided to grant children education allowance (CEA) to Central Government Employees to facilitate

modern education to their children from a well established and well equipped institution. Keeping in mind on the above view the Railway authority has directed the Efficiency Cell of Eastern Railway to conduct work-study and review the role of various Railway Schools at Jamalpur in connection with imparting school education to employee's wards within the railway premises.

- 2.8.0. From the above tables, the under mentioned issues are appraised clearly:
 - Both the nos. of Rly. Students & Non-Rly. Students reduced over the years.
 - Reduction of Nos. of Rly. Students is very sharp over the years in comparison to nos. of Non-Rly. Students.
 - Reduction of Nos. of students in both Eastern Railway M.P. (Mixed Primary) School & Eastern Railway Middle School No. 1 & No. 2. Jamalpur is much higher. The matter of fact is that students enrolled in the Eastern Railway Inter College, Jamalpur remains more or less same over the years.

CHAPTER-III

3.0.0. CRITICAL ANALYSIS:

3.1.0. From the data collected from the Schools of Jamalpur, under the Administrative control of CWM/E.Rly./Jamalpur, it is clear that there is deterioration of students enrolment in those schools in recent years. Study team discusses with teachers, parents/guardians of students to find out the reasons for this deterioration in the new admission in this type of schools. The main reasons found out are as under -

3.1.1. Implementation of children education allowance :

In Central Pay Commission, Indian Railway implemented children education allowance for their employees. In this scheme a Railway employee can get upto Rs. 27,000/- per year per student for providing education for his 02 children. Hostel subsidy allowance can also be permissible to the employee. For this reason Railway employees are now trying to admit their ward in renowned schools which were out of their reach due to excessive tuition fees previously.

3.1.2. In the vicinity of Jamalpur Workshop / Jamalpur Railway Colonies, there are a good nos. of English Medium Schools.

3.2.0. Suggestion:

It is suggested that all the said three schools may be brought within a common campus after broadening the operating area of E. Rly. Inter College / Jamalpur. Such steps may be very much beneficial for the students of primary & middle schools also, as the modern infra-structure of E. Rly. Inter College / Jamalpur can be availed by all the students irrespective of classes they read in. Moreover, the day to day activities of school may by performed more smoothly and efficiently under one roof and one Institution-cumadministrative head.

In the light of above, it is clear that there will be no necessity to fill-up the 11 nos. vacant posts of Eastern Railway M.P. (Mixed Primary) School, Jamalpur & Eastern Railway Middle School No. 1 & No. 2. Jamalpur (as mentioned in TABLE-B of Para 2.2.0. & 2.3.0.).

3.3.0. **Recommendation:** In the context of above, the study team recommends that 11 posts of different category School Teacher under CWM/E.Rly./JMP may be surrendered immediately from the existing sanctioned strength.
