Sub: Incorrect reversion of S/Shri A.L. Gurjar,
P.S. Sawhney and P.C. Gupta, S.A.O(PTA)
DLI - Western Railway.

I am directed to refer to your letter No.QM-61/28 dated 30.1.1987 and Item No.B-38 of the minutes of the PNM-NFIR Meeting held with the Board on 22/23.1.1987 on the above subject and to state that the matter has been examined further in the light of the points made by the Federation in their letter *ibid*.

2.1 As the Federation are aware, S/Shri A.L. Gurjar, P.S. Sawhney and P.C. Gupta were officiating as Clerk Grade I against leave vacancies as on 25.9.69 i.e. the date of issue of Board's orders regarding reversion of CG-I against leave vacancies on the expiry of such vacancies and they were reverted only thereafter i.e. on 7.11.70, 7.11.70 and 31.10.70 respectively. You will in the circumstances appreciate that there is no retrospective effect of Board's instructions dated 25.9.69 in this case.

2.2. Further, the fact that S/Shri Solanki, Kapoor and Hoogan were confirmed by the Western Railway Administration w.e.f. 1.4.68, 1.4.68 and 16.5.69 was known to this Ministry and is presumably the basis of allowing special dispensation in the year 1972 and 1974 regarding confirmation of S/Shri Madan Singh ; S.M. Sharma and B.S. Rathore w.e.f. 1.4.68. This, however, does not make any difference in so far as the Federation's demand regarding proforma fixation of pay of S/Shri Gurjar, Sawhney and Gupta is concerned.


2.3. As regards Western Railway's proposal for proforma fixation to S/Shri Gurjar, Sawhney and Gupta, it is informed that the recommendations of the Western Railway Administration in this regard were considered by the Board in the year 1979 and

no merit was found therein.

3. In these circumstances, the Federation will appreciate that, at this stage, there is no scope for allowing proforma fixation to S/Shri A.L. Gurjar, P.S. Sawhney and P.C. Gupta. The Ministry of Railways hope that the Federation will agree to treat this item as closed.
