Sub: Har Ghar Tiranga Scheme

Ref: Board's letter No.E(W)2019/FU-1/4 dated 30.09.2019.

Under the aegis of the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM)', the scheme of 'Har Ghar Tiranga' scheme has been launched to encourage citizens (including all Government officials) to hoist the National Flag in their homes from 13th -15 th August, 2022.

- 2.1 The objectives of the HGT Scheme specified by the Ministry of Culture are as follows:
 - a) Hoisting of Indian National Flag by more than 20 Crore households across India from 13th to 15th August 2022.
 - b) Campaign to encourage citizens to hoist National Flag of India in their homes to mark 75th Independence Day.
 - c) Instill feeling of patriotism and acknowledge the journey of India in the last 45 years.
 - d) Ensure that People purchase the Flags under the campaign to impart a sense of Ownership.
- 2.2 Har Ghar Tiranga Enablers and Key Pointers of the Amended Flag Code are as follows:
 - a) Flexibility in Material permitted for preparation of flags polyester, Cotton, Wool, Silk and Khadi bunting material permitted.
 - b) Permitted sizes: Length to Height (Width) Ratio of 3:2 to be maintained. No size restriction.
 - c) Machine Made Flags permitted in addition to Hand-made Flags.
 - d) A member of public, a private organization or an educational institution may hoist/display the National Flag on all days and occasions.
- 3. The HGT execution strategy along with Indicative Listings of the Indian National Flag on GeM platforms is given in Annexure-A.
- 4. In view of the above, the Board have decided that the National Flags for all employees on your Railway may be purchased from the money lying unspent under Staff Benefit Fund. The Board have also decided to authorise SBF Committees functional on ZRs/PUs/Divisions to utilise the SBF money lying unspent (in accordance with provisions of SBF) for the said purchase of National Flags to be further provided to the railway employees. Further, the SBF amount may be recouped by the money received from Railway employees against the purchase of National Flags and SBF Committees should keep an account of all expense and income thereof.
