Sub: Liberalized Active Retirement Scheme for Guaranteed Employment for Safety Staff (LARSGESS) - Assessment of suitability of wards for appointment in posts with Grade Pay of Rs.1800/- regarding.

Ref: Your Railway's letter No. PB/CS/30/LARSGESS/Vol. VII dated 12.12.2011 and 11.01.2012.

The issues raised in your above referred letters have been considered in Board's Office. It is intimated that action taken in respect of keeping minimum pass percentage at 25% for recruitment of ST candidates under LARSGESS at par with that prescribed by RRB is in order.

2. The ward of the employee, who has been promoted as Technician III, after he applied for retirement under the Scheme cannot be made ineligible for recruitment under the Scheme as in accordance with the provisions contained in Board's letter dated 15.07.2011 the ward is to be considered for appointment only in the lowest recruitment GP of Rs.1800 of the respective category from which the employee seeks retirement on the cut off date.
