Sub: Recommendations of the Running Allowances Committee-Admissibility of Allowance in lieu of Kilometrage to the running staff participating in enquiries-Calculation of Subsistence Allowance for running staff under suspension-Regarding.

In continuation of Board's letter No.E(P&A)II-80/RS-10 dt. 17.7.81 regarding implementation of the recommendations of the Committee on Running Allowances, the Ministry of Railways have had under consideration the acceptance of the following two recommendations of the Committee on Running Allowances:-

- i) Running staff participating in enquiries conducted against them should be entitled to ALK (for head-quarters and outstation) irrespective of the outcome of the enquiries.
- ii) For purpose of calculation of subsistence allowance for running staff under suspension, 30% of the basic pay of the running staff concerned should be treated as pay.

2. It has now been decided that

- i) the running staff, who are not under suspension and who are required to attend departmental enquiries or law courts may be allowed Allowance in lieu of Kilometrage in terms of para 3.5 of Board's letter of 17.7.81 as amended from time to time, irrespective of the outcome of the enquiry. Running staff under suspension, when required to attend Departmental enquiries/law courts, may be granted Travelling Allowance as for other railway servants as envisaged under ~~para 3.19 RI~~; and
- ii) in the case of running staff, 30% of basic pay representing the pay element in the Running Allowance may be included for calculating the subsistence Allowance payable during the periods of suspension. This would otherwise also become admissible in terms of para 3.23(i)(b) of the Board's letter of 17.7.81 referred to above as 30% of the pay of running staff is to be treated as pay element of Running Allowance for the purpose of leave salary and accordingly, under Rule 2043-R-II the Subsistence Allowance will automatically become payable on the basis of such leave salary during suspension.

These orders have the sanction of the President and issue in consultation with the Finance Directorate of this Ministry.
