

Copy of Railway Board's letter No.E(P&A)II-80/HW-1 dt.
12th November '81 addressed to All G.Ms and other concerned.

Sub: Weightage for Night Duty - Revised hourly rates
of Night Duty Allowance.

Ref: Railway Ministry's letter No.PC(3) 73/NDA
dated 16.9.1975.

Consequent upon the grant of additional dearness allowance to railway employees in terms of Railway Ministry's letter No.PCIII/81/DA dated 7.1.1981, 6.4.1981, 14.7.1981 and 21.9.1981 with effect from 1.9.1980, 1.12.1980, 1.2.1981 and 1.4.1981 respectively the revised rates of Night Duty Allowance with effect from 1.9.80, 1.12.1980, 1.2.1981 and 1.4.1981 to staff drawing pay in the revised scales of pay are indicated ~~xx~~ in the enclosed Annexures 'A' and 'B' showing the revised rates of Night Duty Allowance per weighted hour for 'Continuous' 'intensive' excluded Class III Staff' under Hours of Employment Regulations and Workshop Staff in respect of various classified cities, and also the revised rates of Night Duty Allowance payable to these classified as 'essentially intermittent' under Hours of Employment Regulations.

2. These rates will also apply to Railway Servants who have selected to retain the pre-revised scales of pay. In their case pay for the purpose of determining the rates of pay as indicated in Annexures 'A' and 'B' to this letter will include the basic pay, special pay, personal pay, Dearness Pay, Dearness allowances and Interim Reliefs as admissible on the basic pay as on 31.12.1972. In this connection, the instructions contained in ~~xxxxx~~ this Ministry's letter No.PC(3) 73 NDA dated 24.1.1980 are relevant.

3. The conditions laid down in paras 4 & 5 of Railway Ministry's letter No.PC(3) 73/NDA dated 16.9.75, referred to above shall continue to apply.

4. The payment of Night Duty allowance already drawn by the Railway employees in terms of Railway Ministry's letter No. E(P&A)II-80/HW-1 dated 15.12.1980 should be revised and arrears due, if any, should be paid to them.

5. This has the sanction of the President and issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.

6. The Railway Ministry desire that payment of arrears to the concerned staff should be made by 31st January 1982 and a report on the payment having been made sent to them latest by 15th February 1982.
