under SEF.

In the PNM Meeting held in September, 1997 NFIR had raised a demand that the Ayurvedic/Homoeopathic physicians employed by the Staff Benefit Fund Committees should be allowed the benefit of privilege passes and PTOs. The issue has been carefully considered by the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) and it has since been decided that the full time regular Homoeopathic/Ayurvedic physicians engaged by the Staff Benefit Fund Committees as well as other full time regular employees engaged by the Staff Benefit Fund Committees should be allowed Complimentary Passes and Concessional Ticket Orders on the same scale as admissible to full time regular staff of quasi Railway institutions like Co-operative Credit and Consumer Societies/Banks/Railway Institutes/Libraries etc. as per item No.18(v) of Schedule VII (Special Passes) of the Railway servants (Pass) Rules, 1986.

2. In view of the above the Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, 1986 may be amended as per the Advance Correction Slip No.17 enclosed.
3. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
