> Sub: Qualifying Railway service for grant of postretirement complimentary passes.

Various Central Administrative Tribunale have been delivering judgements for grant of post-retirement complimentary passes to those Railway employees, who joined Railways from other State/Central Government Departments, taking into consideration of their past services rendered in non-hailway Departments. In the case of two Special Leave petitions filed (Civil Appeal No. 8327/97 Dr. S. Balier Singh Ve DOI and Civil Appeal No. 1701 of 1997 Dr. Jegdishwar Bhatt Vs UOI) the bonourable Supreme Court vide their judgement have set at rest all controversies regarding qualifying service for postretirement passes. The minimum qualifying service required for grant of post-retirement complimentary pass in 20 years of service rendered on the Railways. They have also upheld the Railway Board's rights to relax the rules in individual cases on merita. The judgement categorally laye down that the provision of other Rules (e.g. Pension Rules) could not be imparted into Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, Copies of the judgement referred to above are sent Marawith for

information and guidance.
