Sub:- Passes and PTOs to the staff of the Railway. Audit Department.

Further to the orders governing the grant of passes/FTOs to the staff of Railway Audit Department contained in the Railway Loard's letter No. 4379-T dated 26.2.1935, it is clarified that rasses and PTOs ma, be lissed to officers and staff of the Railway Audit Department including officers of the I.A. & A.S. serving in Railway Audit Branch irrespective of their date of joining the Railway Audit Department. The scale of passes/PTOs and the rules governing their issue will be the same as applicable to railway servants from time to time.

- 2. In the case of officers of the I.A. & A. S., the issue of process/10s when proceeding on long leave, i.e. leaveexceeding four rouths, passes/PTOs will be admissible provided they have completed not less than one year's service in the Railway Audit Departed, and provided also that the Auditor General in India declared in each case that the officers will probably return to a Railway Audit or Accounts office on the expiry of leave.
- 3. Passes/PTOs will be issued by the Chief Auditors irrespective of home or foreign line.
- 1. The officers of the Indian Audit & Accounts Service working in the Reilway Audit Department will not be granted certificates to enable them to obtain travel concessions on Railways outside India
- 4. The Reilway Board's letter of even No. dated 2.4.1960 may please be treated as cancelled.
