Sub: Inspection carriages to Railway magistrates.

Reference Board's letter No.E(G)61PS5-2/6 dated 5.4.1962 wherein it has been stated that the Railway Magistrates may be given Inspection Carriages provided they can be spared and their use is necessary in the interest of railway work.

The Government servants on the civil side, who are allowed free transit by railway, are entitled to travelling allowance in terms of S.R.176. This may please be brought to the notice of the State Governments so that they may amend their Travelling Allowance Rules applicable to the special and other stipendary Railway Magistrates who use Inspection Carriages, where provided. The details of duty card passes issued to such Railway Magistrates and their staff may also be intimated to the State Governments concerned to enable them to take these passes into account while allowing Travelling Allowance to the officials concerned.
