Sub:-Absorption in alternative employment of
medically decategorised staff.

Following are the extracts of Inspection Note of Chairman,
Railway Board recorded pursuant to discussions with officers of
Southern and S.C. Railways at Chennai on 12.10.2001:-

"6.4. There are a large number of decategorised surplus staff in
some of the railways. As per present instructions they cannot be
given any other scale. The issue needs to be re-examined. We
should identify some categories in each of the department, where
for redeployment of these decategorised staff, we may lower the
medical requirement.

2. The matter has been considered in consultation with DG/RHS,
Railway Board who has desired that the Zonal Railways may make
necessary recommendations with requisite details of posts Department-
wise which can be identified for lowering the existing medical
requirement for the purpose of absorption of medically decategorised
staff. No doubt such recommendations will be made by the Zonal
Railways in consultation with concerned PHOD and the CMD.

30.12.2001 in the proforma annexed herewith.
