It has come to the notice of the Board that most of the attendants attached to the first class Corridor Coaches have not been confirmed. This is probably due to nonavailability of permanent posts in the cadre. The Board have carefully considered the question and have decided that a scheme of making posts of corridor coach attendants permanent may be worked out in consultation with the F.A.&C.A.O. on the basis of the following yardstick: 1. One Coach attendant for 2 coaches vestibuled to each other. For this purpose, the possibility of vestibuling more coaches should be kept in view so that permanent posts do not become surplus later. 2.
