
The undersigned is directed to refer to the Rajya Sabha Secretariat O.M.NO. RS. 5(36)/80-Com. I dated 18th September 1980 and to give the information required to the points mentioned in the O.M. referred to above in Seriatum.

- 1) No.
- ii) Promotions are made division-wise and this category is filled by calling volunteers from Class IV Staff in the Traffic Branch and by a process of selection.
- iii) Total strength of First Class Coach Attendants working in Southern Railway during the last 3 years is as under:-

<u>No. promoted to Class III Posts</u>	2	15	19

First Class Coach Attendants besides seeking further avenues in their parent cadre such as Pointsmen, Levermen etc. are entitled to volunteer themselves for consideration for promotion to Class III Posts such as Train Clerks, Ticket Collectors etc. to the extent of 33-1/3% set apart for Class IV Staff for promotion to Class III Posts.

- iv) As stated above, First Class Coach Attendants have regular avenue of promotion in their cadre besides being considered for Class III Posts within the approved percentage fixed. No further avenues are contemplated for their advancement as any revision in the existing percentage can not be done without considering the case of other similar Class IV categories on the Railways.
