Representations have been received requesting for alteration of the recorded date of birth on the basis of the subsequent revision of date of birth in their Secondary School Leaving Certificates (Metriculation Certificates) by the State Educational Authorities on the direction of Court orders obtained by the employees.

The last letter received by this Railway on the subject from Board is one cited above (copy enclosed for ready reference) by which the Chief Personnel Officer may agree to change in the recorded date of birth provided the change in date of birth is based on the Matriculation Certificate and a reasomable explanation is forthcoming about the delay in asking for a change.

I shall be glad if you could please clarify the position whether the CPO may act on the direction given in the above cited Board's letter or if any other revised orders are in vogue. If it is the latter case, a copy of the order may please be sent early.
