Sub: Promotion of Class III Staff against
Selection posts.

Reference Railway Board's letter No.E(NG)56PM1-36
dated 22.1.60 regarding automatic empanelment in the
intermediate grade selection post, of an employee who is
selected for a higher grade selection post. It has been
represented to the Board that an employee of the type
referred to would stand to lose in seniority to another
employee who is not selected for the higher grade post
but has been ranked as "outstanding" in the panel for
the intermediate grade selection post in terms of this
office letter No. E(NG) 57PM1-24 dated 8.10.58. The Board
have considered the question and, in partial modification

of their letter No. E(NG) 56PM1-36 dated 22-1-60 have decided that if the selection Board for the intermediate grade selection post have placed some persons as "outstanding" in that case, an employee selected for a higher grade Class III Selection post or a Class II post in his normal channel of promotion may be deemed to have been classified as "outstanding" and given due place in accordance with his seniority amongst those classified by the Selection Board as "Outstanding" for the intermediate grade selection post, provided the selection for that post is held after such an employee has already been selected for the higher grade selection post.
