

Copy of Railway Board's letter No.E(NG)64/CL/25 dated  
25.7.64 received under GM/P/KMS letter NO.P(RT)531/XII/1  
dated 7.8.64.

Sub:- Promotion of Class IV Staff  
Service rendered by C.L. after  
the grant of temporary status and  
before their regular appointment  
against Class IV posts.

Reference Board's letter NO.E(NG)580PP/8 dated  
23.4.62 wherein it was stipulated that all Class IV  
employees should have put in atleast 5 years continuous  
service in that cadre for being considered for promotion  
to Class III posts. A doubt has arisen whether the service  
rendered by a person initially appointed as Casual Labour  
and granted temporary status after six months continuous  
service and finally absorbed in regular Class IV post can be  
counted for purposes of his promotion to Class III post.  
The Board have decided that all continuous temporary service  
preceding permanent absorption in the regular cadre may be  
counted in reckoning the 5 year qualifying service in such  
cases.
