Reference Board's letter of even number dated 17.9.1964. It was laid down in para 1(iii) thereof that the C.C.S. should pick up suitable staff from various divisions. It appears that such discretion is being used to pick up staff working in any lower grade to fill up the vacancies in the higher grade. The Board wish to clarify that the in picking up the suitable staff only those who may be working in the same grade on a particular division or divisions should be considered and not those in the lower grade(s). As an incentive the Board have already sanctioned a special pay of Rs.25/- P.M. to such staff while working in the Hd. Quarters flying Squads vide this office letter No. E(NG)61PA8/6 dated 19.2.1965.
