Sub:- Avenue of promotion for Trains Clerks.


In a P.N.M. meeting with the organised labour at the level of the Railway Board, the following minutes were recorded:-

"The avenue of promotion available to Assistant Station Masters at present in the category of Guards Gr. 'C' should be thrown open to Trains Clerks. Train Clerks should also be considered for promotion against 1/3rd of the direct recruitment quota in the category of Guard Gr. 'C' in addition."

2. As per extant instructions 33.1/3% of the vacancies of Guards Grade 'C' in scale Rs.130-225(AS) are filled by direct recruitment. 20% of vacancies are required to be filled by promotion of eligible Trains Clerks in scale Rs.110-180(AS) and those officiating in scale Rs.150-240(AS). The remaining vacancies are filled from amongst Assistant Station Masters, Commercial Clerks, Ticket Collectors, Trains Clerks, Yard staff, Brakesmen etc. according to percentages laid down by each Railway Administration.

3. The Board have now decided that the vacancies of Guards Grade 'C' (Rs.130-225) at present available to Assistant Station Masters should be thrown open also to Trains Clerks. In addition, Trains Clerks should also be considered for promotion to 1/3rd of the vacancies reserved for direct recruitment in the category of Guards Grade 'C', curtailing the direct recruitment accordingly.


