Sub: Procedure for filling up selection posts-Non-gazetted.

Reference Railway Board's letters No.E(NG)62PMI/91 dated 10.7.1964, No.E(NG)I/68PMI/192 dated 13.11.1968 and 30.4.69 and E(NG)I/69PMI/200 dated 18.3.1970. It has come to the notice of the Board that for the purpose of calculating anticipated vacancies in respect of forming panels of selection posts vacancies arising out of leave arrangements and others and against proposals in the offing for creation of additional posts for survey work etc. are taken into account. Board observe that there is no objection to take into account only such vacancies which are likely to arise on account of leave preparatory to retirement of staff during the currency of the panel. Other leave vacancies should not be accounted for this purpose. Similarly vacancies against proposals in the offing for creation of additional post for Survey Work etc. should not be taken into account. Only such vacancies which have already been sanctioned at relevant time of assessment of the vacancies should only be taken into account. The existing procedure of the Railway administrations may please be modified.
