Sir:- Avenue of promotion for Laboratory Assistants in the  
Mechanical Department.

In Board's letter of even number dated 5.6.72 it was laid down that  
25% of the vacancies of Junior Chemical and Metallurgical Assistants in  
Rs.150-300 should be filled from amongst the Laboratory Assistants.  
The Board have further considered the matter and decided that the prescribed  
qualification of Degree in Science may be relaxed to "Matriculation or its  
equivalent with Science" for the purpose of promotion of staff against 25%  
vacancies; promotion should be based on selection.

The staff so promoted as Junior Chemical and Metallurgical Assistants  
with relaxed qualification will not be considered for further promotion as  
Chemical and Metallurgical Assistants unless they acquire the minimum qualifi-  
cation viz- Degree in science as prescribed for these posts.
