Railway Board's Confidential letter No.E(NG)I/73PMI/120 dated 11.9.1974 to the Dy.C.P.O., Northern Railway, ...

Sub: Effects of refusal on promotion.

Kindly refer to your letter No.940-E/0-11 (EIV) dated 29.6.1974 on the above subject. During recent and work to rule agitations, there were many cases where deliberately refused to work in the higher post even at the station resulting in dislocation of normal services. The Board issued the orders in their letter No.E(NG)I/73PMI/120 dated 2.2.1974 in that context to clothe the Railway Administration powers to deal with recalcitrant staff. It is, however, the competent authority to decide in which cases D&A action is warranted and in which cases the employees concerned have genuine difficulties or reasons for not wanting the promotions. In the latter type/accept the request of the staff and allow them to continue at the existing grade.

Of cases, the competent authority can always
