
Sub: Filling up of vacancies of Chargemen/Draftsmen
in Electrical/Mechanical Department from amongst
rankers who possess the requisite educational
qualifications.

In accordance with Board's letters No.E(NG)III-71RC1/67
dated 25.11.71 and E(NG)III-71RC1/35 dated 19.8.72, 25% of the
vacancies in the category of Chargemen/Draftsmen Rs.425-700(Rs)
are to be filled by rankers who possess the requisite quali-
fications. The qualifications for the intermediate Apprentice
Mechanics drawn from skilled workmen are laid down in Board's
letter No.E(Trg)I-66TRI/19 dated 15-3-66 which are as under:-

- (i) Must have passed Matriculation or equivalent
examination.
- (ii) Must have completed trade Apprenticeship Course
with credit.
- (iii) Must have attained a very good standard of profi-
ciency in his trade.
- (iv) Must have satisfactory service record with respect
to application of work, attendance and general
conduct.

The age limit for rankers is 38 years vide Board's letter
No.E(NG)I-73PM1/243 dated 8.11.73.

With the decision to recruit Diploma holders only as
Apprentice Mechanics against the direct recruitment quota,
a doubt has been raised as to whether the rankers should be
Diploma holders in order to be eligible for consideration as
Intermediate Apprentice Mechanics against the 25% vacancies
in the category of Chargemen/Draftsmen in grade Rs.425-700(Rs.).
It is clarified that rankers to be so recruited should have
passed Matriculation or equivalent examination as prescribed
in Board's letter of 15-3-66 referred to above.
