The Ministry of Railways have had under
consideration the question of classifying the posts of
librarians for whom following scales have been standardized
on the recommendations of the Third Pay Commission:


Asstt. Librarian	- Rs.330-560
Asstt. Librarian/ Librarian/Asstt. Documentalist	Rs.425-700
Chief Documentalist- cum-Librarian	Rs.550-900

After careful consideration, the Ministry
of Railways have decided that wherever the posts of Asstt.
librarians exist in scale Rs.330-560, the same should be
filled on the basis of selection from amongst the volunteers
from other categories of staff on the Railways. After
having filled these posts after selection, the next
two higher grade posts should be filled on suitability
basis. However, wherever the lowest grade posts are not

available and Posts of Librarians are available only in scale Rs.425-700 and above, in such cases the posts in scale Rs.425-700 may be filled by drafting staff, who volunteer from other categories on 'selection' basis and in that case the higher grade post in scale Rs.550-900 may alone be filled on suitability basis.
