Sub:- Calculation of vacancies for non-selection posts.

The question of calculation of vacancies for the purpose of filling non-selection posts came up for discussion in the last Conference of the CPOs held in October 1978. Some of the Railway Administrations pointed out difficulties in holding suitability tests at frequent intervals as the calculation of vacancies does not allow them sufficient margin to meet the requirements of unexpected vacancies arising during the period. Attention in this connection is invited to instructions contained in Boards' letter No. E(NG)I/72/PMI/55 dated 29.1.74 wherein it was provided that the number of candidates to be called for suitability tests should be equal to the actual vacancies existing and those anticipated in the next three months due to retirements.

In view of the difficulties mentioned by the Railway Administrations in the Conference, the matter has been reviewed at a great length by the Ministry of Railways and it has been/in supercession of earlier order that calculation of vacancies for non selections posts should hereafter be made according to the vacancies anticipated to occur during the next three months due to retirements or creation of new posts plus 20% thereof.
