Sub : Promotional courses for promotion of
Drivers to grades 'C', 'B' & 'A' on
Indian Railways.

According to para 117(a) of Chapter I of the
Indian Railways Establishment Manual, promotional courses
as necessary may be prescribed by the General Managers
according to the need of each case. In the context of
avoiding accidents, the need for prescription and
adherence to such courses cannot be over-emphasized,
specially for promotion to the category of Drivers.
Ministry of Railways, therefore, desire that promotional
courses where necessary should be prescribed, if not
already done, and it should be ensured that staff are
spared and made to attend such courses.
