

Vide Board's letter No.E(NG)I-77 PM1/11 dated 3-11-1977, the age limit for filling up 10% of the vacancies of Traffic and Commercial Apprentices on the basis of limited departmental examination from amongst Class III staff of Commercial and Transportation Departments (other than ministerial staff) who were Graduates was fixed at 35 years. Ministry of Railways have further considered the matter and have decided that the age limit shall be 40 years instead of 35 years. These instructions will apply to the selections which are processed after issue of this letter.


2. It may also be reiterated that the selection for filling up the vacancies of Traffic Apprentices and Commercial Apprentices through departmental examination should be regularly held every year.
