Subject:- Calculation of vacancies for selection posts.

In terms of para 216(d) of Chapter II, Section 'B' of the Indian Railway Establishment Manual for selection to non-gazetted posts on the Indian Railways, candidates to the extentof four times the number of existing and anticipated vacancies plus 25% thereof for unforseen vacancies were to be considered. Ministry of Railways later vide their letter NO.E(NG)I-76-PMI-168 dated 3.9.1976 decided that selection panels should not cater for unforseen vacancies i.e. the number of candidates to be considered should normally be equal to 3 times the number of existing and anticipated vacancies. In the PNM Meeting held with N.F.I.R., on 23/24.12.1981, the N.F.I.R. raised the general question of calculation of vacancies to determine the number of persons to be called for selection. The matter has been considered in detail in the Ministry of Railways after consultation with the Two Federations and they have decided as under:-

For selection posts within the cadre, the existing vacancies plus those anticipated (as defined below) during the course of mext one year should be taken into account. For unforseen contigencies, 20% of the anticipated vacancies only (not of existing vacancies) should be added to the existing and anticipated vacancies;

For selection posts in the Const. Organisation, 50 % of the number of posts which exist in the grade under considerati .& higher grades for a period of one year on the assessment date and which are likely to continue should be taken into account.

For ex-cadre posts, actual vacancies plus those anticipated iii)

to occur in the next 2 years should be considered.

The concept of anticipated vacancies should be deemed to connote the following type of vacancies:-

vacancies on account of normal wastage viz. retirement or superannuation:

vacancies likely to be caused as a result of staff having f b) given notice for voluntary retirement! provided the same are likely to be accepted;

vacancies in higher grades in the channel the filling up. which will result in the need to make consequent appointme s

from the proposed panel; vacancies likely to be caused due to staff approved to go on

deputation to other Units;

number of staff already empanelled for ex-cadre posting; vacancies likely to arise due to creation of additional f)

posts in higher grades and also in the same grade. This may include only those proposals which have been concurred in by Accounts and approved by the Competent Authority; and

the vacancies arising out of the cases where staff are likely to go out on transfer to other Railways/Divisions during g) the period under consideration.
