Sub:- Refusal of promotion and consequential
effect - Promotion against vacancies as
a result of upgradation.

Reference this Ministry's letters No.PC-III-80/
UPG/19 dated 20.12.83 and PC-III-83/UPG/3 dated 1.5.84.

2. Attention is invited to this Ministry's letter
No.E(NG)64PM1-66 dated 21.1.65 as clarified/modified
from time to time, in terms of which refusal of promotion
results in the staff concerned being debarred for future
promotion for one year.

3. The National Federation of Indian Railwaymen have
represented that such of the employees as stand debarred
for promotion as a result of their refusal to accept
promotion, may be considered for promotion, in relaxation
of the orders quoted above, against vacancies arising out
of recent restructuring ordered in this Ministry's letter
of 20.12.83, as in many cases staff have become due for
promotion to more than one grade above the post held by
them at present and they could not have anticipated such
large scale upgradation when they refused to accept promotion.

4. The matter has been considered carefully. It has
been decided that as a one time exception:

- (a) such of the staff as had refused promotion
immediately before issue of orders of restructur-
ing contained in this Ministry's letter of
20.12.83 may be considered for promotion if
they indicate in writing that they are willing
to be considered for such promotion, against
vacancies existing on 1-1-1984 and arising due to
restructuring. This relaxation will not be
applicable to vacancies arising after 1-1-84; and
- (b) similar relaxation as at (a) above will apply
mutatis-mutandis in respect of vacancies covered
by the restructuring ordered in this Ministry's
letter of 1.5.1984.




