EXTRACTS TAKEN FROM THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED TO REVIEW THE WORKING OF THE PSYCHO TECHNICAL CELL OF RDSO

- H. SECOND OPPORTUNITY IN IN-SERVICE SELECTIONS
- The Committee was perplexed to find that for 30. inservice psycho-testing, different practices exist and unlimited number of opportunities are given to candidates to enable them to pass psycho-test for promotion to Pointsman/Leverman. and Engine Cleaner. It is noted that there is a large backlog of non-screened staff working on the job and numerous instances exist where the staff get more than 2 to 3 promotions beyond the stage where psycho testing is mandatory. The failure rate of about 15% in these categories has not caused any concern among the railwaymen in general, perhaps, due to repeated opportunities being given to clear the tests. It appears that departmental psycho-testing has not been taken in a serious manner. This problem has been compounded because of two reasons.

Railway Board vide their circular No. E(NG)I/77/ PM-1/247 dated 26th April, 1979 indicated that the staff who failed in the psycho-test would be diverted to the maintenance side in loco sheds or brakesmen, train clerks and other clerical categories, as the case may be. But it however, did not specify whether a 'second' opportunity would be given to candidates who failed at the first opportunity. Secondly, RDSO on their own, have stipulated that "the failures in psycho-test would not bar candidates from taking the test again as and when fresh selection proceedings are gone through. No appeal will lie against results of psycho test." This has resulted in confusion with no uniform or standard procedure being followed by the Zonal Railways.

31. The Committee is of the firm view that present aberrations should not be allowed to continue. It is recommended that not more than two opportunities be given to any staff to qualify in psycho-test. The second opportunity is recommended in view of a likelihood of transient disturbances occurring during the first testing. The second opportunity may be given only after a lapse of six months. The record pertaining to this aspect has to be maintained properly on the Zonal Railways.
