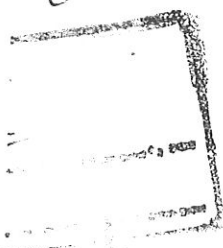
2 The recommendation as contained in your Railway's

The cadre of Cashiers (Non-supervisory) of the Cash and Pay Department has been allowed a revised percentage structure with provision of a higher scale of Rs.1600-2660 to the extent of 20% with effect from 1.3.93 in terms of Annexure-F(i) of the Board's letter dated 27.1.93 and 7.4.93.

2. Accordingly, the question of prescribing a standard designation for the posts in the grade Rs.1600-2660 now introduced as well as regulating procedure for filling up the vacancies in that grade has been under consideration of the Board for quite sometime.

3. It has now been decided that the posts of the Cashiers (Non-supervisory) may henceforth be redesignated, as under :-
